Become a part of bringing tennis to Keizer! The Keizer Tennis Association (KTA) is partnering with the City of Keizer to build tennis courts at the new Keizer Rapids Park. The Keizer City has committed **\$50,000** of parks system development funds for the construction of tennis courts at Keizer Rapids Park.

Few sports have the range of benefits and life-long enjoyment as tennis. Tennis is a great family sport, engaging the whole family in heart-healthy activity, fighting obesity, and teaching responsibility, respect, tactical thinking, and sportsmanship. Participation in tennis is multi-cultural, multi-generational, and affordable – all you need is a racket, a can of balls and, of course, a decent court.

Responding to the community need for tennis programming, the Keizer Tennis Association offers low-cost tennis instruction for all ages. We served nearly 120 children and adults within the Keizer community in our first year. This program was enthusiastically received and we plan to serve over 200 children and adults this summer.

Unfortunately, there are **no adequate tennis facilities** in Keizer to serve its 36,000 residents. There are two City of Keizer courts individually located in Willamette Manor Park and Bob Newton Park. Both are in poor condition. McNary High School has four courts that require major repairs.

Our goal is to construct a minimum of six professional class courts at Keizer Rapids Park. Please consider a donation today and let's make the dream of beautiful tennis courts a reality!
